

NOTICE TO BIDDERS
VILLAGE OF CELORON, NEW YORK
IMPROVEMENTS TO LUCILLE BALL MEMORIAL PARK, SEA WALL &
BOARDWALK

The Board of Trustees of the Village of Celoron, NY, hereby requests sealed bids from qualified firms to perform improvements to Lucille Ball Memorial Park, Sea Wall & Boardwalk. Work will include: existing dock/pile removal; seawall removal and replacement with heavy-stone rip-rap; installation of a rootwad revetment with branch packing; select clean fill; installation of helical piles and wood boardwalk; sawcutting asphalt/concrete; utilities work; and installation of a prefabricated floating handicapped-accessible kayak/canoe launch with gangway. Sealed bids clearly marked with the firm's name and labeled "Bid for Village of Celoron Improvements to Lucille Ball Memorial Park, Sea Wall & Boardwalk" will be received at, or before, **4:30 P.M., Monday, October 30, 2017**, at the Office of the Village Clerk-Treasurer, 21 Boulevard Avenue, P. O. Box 577, Celoron, NY 14720-0577, at which time and place they will be publicly opened and read aloud. There will be a pre-bid site visit on Tuesday, October 17, 2017 at 4 PM. Said meeting will be held at the Lucille Ball Memorial Park, across the street from the Village Office. All interested parties are strongly encouraged to attend. Bid documents may be obtained online at the New York State Contract Reporter website at: <http://www.nyscr.ny.gov>; or on the Village of Celoron website: www.celoronny.org. Copies of the bid documents may be examined at no expense at the Village of Celoron Office during the Village's normal hours of operation, or at the office of Greenman-Pedersen, Inc., 4950 Genesee St, Suite 100, Buffalo, NY 14225, by appointment. The Village of Celoron shall not be held responsible for the completeness or accuracy of any bid documents received by a vendor that were not directly issued to that vendor by the Village of Celoron through the above-mentioned means. Any vendor submitting a bid based on incomplete or inaccurate information resulting from documentation received from any third party, shall not have cause for relief from award or completion of a contract in accordance with the official documents on file with the Village of Celoron. Each bid must be accompanied by a bid bond or certified check in the amount of five percent (5%) of the amount of the bid. No bidder may withdraw his/her bid within forty-five (45) days of the date of the receipt of the bid. The Village Board of Trustees reserves the right to reject any or all bids or portions thereof, and/or to accept the bid or portions thereof deemed most advantageous to the Village of Celoron, NY. Minority and Women-Owned Business Enterprises (MWBE) are encouraged to respond. Funding for this project is being provided by the New York State Department of State (NYS DOS) with funds provided under Title 11 of the Environmental Protection Fund. The selected contractor must comply with all provisions in the contract between the NYS DOS and the Village, including the NYS DOS MWBE goals. The overall MWBE participation goal for this project has been established at \$120,266, with 50% participation from Minority-Owned Business Enterprises (MBE) and 50% participation from Women-Owned Business Enterprises (WBE). Respondents are expected to demonstrate how they expect to achieve this goal.
