Deputy Mayor Schrecengost asked if there was anyone present who wished to address this public hearing on the 2013-2014 Tentative Budget to please step to the front, give your name, address and please limit your comments to three minutes.

Rick Slagle, 105 Merlin Avenue, addressed the public hearing. He questioned the increased spending given the loss of population from 2000 to 2010. He was opposed to the increase to the Clerk's salary account. He felt that more money should have been taken from the fund balance to decrease the tax levy.

Warren Gertsch, 103 N. Hanford Ave., questioned the line item for the Village Attorney's Contractual Account. He demanded an answer from the Deputy Mayor.

Deputy Mayor Schrecengost replied that this was a public hearing to hear comment on the Tentative Budget. He advised Mr. Gertsch that he would get back to him at a later time.
