Deputy Mayor Mattison asked if there was anyone present who wished to address this public hearing to please step to the front, give your name, address and please limit your comments to three minutes.

Shane Uber, representing H. Jacks Plumbing and the Langers, stated that his clients have been maintaining this property and would like to see the Village abandon the street right of ways and deed them to the abutting property owners, thereby creating a buffer. In his opinion, this abandonment would be beneficial to the Village by the addition of taxable property and shifting the liability from the Village. He assured the Board that any utilities could be protected in the deeds.
